



Neighborhoods separated, destroyed

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

#### Prelitigation: Plans for Construction

- Displace 21,000 mostly minority residents
- Buy up, bulldoze homes at fire sale prices
- Award contracts to big construction firms
- Perform work with white men living outside corridor
- Ignore most human costs (e.g., environment, voice)



Can't Change Rules in Middle of Game

- Freeway planning began early: 1958
- 1st public hearing on Century Freeway: 1963
- NEPA, CEQA became effective late: 1970

#### Disastrous Impact if Freeway Halted By May 1972:

- \$88.6 million spent acquiring 3,388 parcels
- 2,840 units vacated
- Crime, dumping, unsavory activity underway
- Corridor only halfway cleared

If injunction issued, then Caltrans would become one of state's biggest landlords with no tenants or alternative plans




Construction halted until such time as defendants complied with NEPA, CEQA

### Reasoning NEPA Applies to Century Freeway Project

- 'Significant effect on environment': Council Guidelines
- Acquisition of substantial amounts of real estate: FHWA Interim Guidelines
- 'Loud and clear' pro-environment policies of NEPA

### October 14, 1993 Century Freeway opened



- 1. Environmentally-conscious transportation options
- 2. Affordable replacement housing
- 3. Affirmative action
- 4. Job training
- 5. Management workshops
- 6. Child care
- 7. Aesthetically pleasing construction

1. Environmentally-Conscious Transportation Options

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- HOV, light rail integrated into median
- Sound walls, below-street-level construction
- Parking near terminals

2. Affordable Replacement Housing

### 2. Affordable Replacement Housing

- Plan: Build 3,700 replacement units near corridor for up to 12,700 residents
- Problem: By mid-1980s, only 1,300 units built
- Solution: Create Century Housing Corp.
- Result: 4,300 replacement units in corridor and nearly 50,000 affordable units built throughout state

#### Goals

- 65% contracts: Minority businesses, workers
- 10% contracts: Female businesses, workers

3. Affirmative Action



#### Goals

- 65% contracts: Minority businesses, workers
- 10% contracts: Female businesses, workers

#### Results

Minority hiring goals: Met

Female hiring goals: Not met, but still 7%

38% contracts: to minorities, women combined

4. Job Training

- Partnership: LA County Federation of Labor
- Lennox apprenticeship program: 1,000s trained
- Alameda Corridor program: 880 trained
- Result: Prevailing wages for minorities, women

- Technical assistance: Bidding public works projects
- Identify pitfalls: Construction bonds
