Preparing and Distributing Annual Crime Reports

The preparation of Southwestern's annual security report is an ongoing process. Statistics are compiled in accordance with the Uniform Crime Reporting System of the Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The annual crime report statistics are based on Campus Security and LAPD data. To comply with the Clery Act, Southwestern collects relevant online crime statistics from LAPD for locations that are contiguous to or adjacent to the property of Southwestern.

Each year, an email notification is sent to all faculty, staff, and enrolled students, including the link to access this report.
